Eligibility Checklist

- ✓ Commit to taking no less than **Take 12 credits/semester. Exceptions possible for 9 credits.**
- ✓ **Complete steps to apply**

Steps To Apply

- 1 Complete the FAFSA or Madison College Alternate FAFSA **By April 1**
- 2 Complete Madison College Scholars of Promise application **By April 1**
- 3 Complete TOPS+ application **By April 1**
- 4 Interview with TOPS+ team
