

ABOUT THE TILLY SCHOLARSHIP

The TILLY (To Ignite Leadership & Learning in Youth) Scholarship is a life-changing opportunity that covers the full Cost of Attendance for up to four years of a bachelor's degree at an accredited university. Created to ignite leadership and learning in youth, this award supports students who demonstrate outstanding leadership and a commitment to positive change, locally or globally.

ELIGIBILITY

- Attend school in Dane County (Class of 2026)
- Enrolled in AVID Elective Class
- Plan to attend a Bachelor's granting (four year) university
- Demonstrate leadership skills and experience
- Is passionate about a local or global issue and is eager to create positive change

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Completed Formstack application, which includes:

- A list of your extra curricular activities
- 3 Short Essay responses (1250-2500 characters per essay, or approximately 200-400 words):
 - **Tell us why you want to go to college.** (Although you do not need to address every question listed, you may consider: What do you want to study? What experiences are you hoping to gain through classes and outside of classes? How does college fit into your long term goals?)
 - Describe a situation where you have acted as a leader. Provide a specific example of how your leadership has impacted others.
 - As a leader, what is a change you want to make in the community or in the world?
- 2 Letters of Recommendation you will need to provide the names and email addresses of both recommenders
 - 1 Academic recommendation (teacher, counselor principal, AVID/TOPS Coordinator, etc)
 - 1 Community recommendation (coach, boss, mentor, etc)

TIMELINE

October 13, 2025: Application opens January 31, 2026: Application deadline

February 7, 2026: Deadline for letters of recommendation

February/March 2026: Interviews for finalists

April 17, 2026: Award announced
